

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER
MONITORING REQUIREMENTS NOT MET FOR**

We are required to monitor your drinking water on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. Between 1/1/2020 and 12/31/2022, we failed to submit the required samples as indicated below and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

What happened? What is being done? (Describe corrective action)

The Nitrite samples were collected and sent to lab for testing, received samples from lab which were in compliance and submitted to Department of Health and Human Resources (Burea for Public Health). We received a violation for not reporting Nitrite sample results in compliance time frame. The quality of your drinking water was not affected by this violation, we have collected Nitrite samples and sent to lab before and after this violation, all samples were in compliance.
