 CASE #HP 17-042. 115-117 S. Queen Street. Public Hearing. Application requesting a Certificate of Appropriateness to remove and rebuild brick parapet wall. Charles Connolly, applicant.

Charles Connolly, owner and Tom Clevenger, mason provided an explanation of the project stating that he needs to rebuild the parapet wall as the current state of the brick is a safety hazard. He would like to build the top back without the step and cement cap for financial reasons and because he feels the weight of the concrete cap added to the disintegrating of the bricks.
